Here are a few steps for New Student Entering Malaysia



1 Declaration Form

You are required to fill in the form in order to receive the Declaration for Commencement of **Online Classes** and **Accommodation letter** from UTM as below :

2 Submit Declaration Form

Upon you fill in the form, UTM will submit your Declaration to EMGS.



3 e-VAL Approved

Upon declaration submitted, e-VAL will be processed & approved by Immigration Department.



4 LOU and Indemnity & Travel Notice

Download, fill and sign the Letter of Undertaking and Indemnity (LOU) and obtain the travel notice from the nearest Malaysian Mission office nearest in your home country. Please download the LOU from :

5 Single - Entry Visa (SEV)

Students from countries that requires Single-Entry Visa (SEV) to enter Malaysia are required to submit their SEV application to the nearest Malaysian Mission Office in their countries.



6 COVID-19 test at entry point

Students are required to undergo the RT-PCR Covid-19 Test **three (3) days** travelling to Malaysia. The RT-PCR Covid-19 test result must be translated in **ENGLISH** so that the respective authorities in Malaysia can inspect it.



7 Online Payment

Students to complete the online payment for the quarantine and the Covid-19 Screening Test through MySafeTravel (www.safetravel.myeg.com.my) / MyQr application by MyEG (www.myeg.gov.my) and provide the payment slip at the international entry point upon arrival.



8 Cost of Quarantine & COVID-19 Test

Kindly note that all fees imposed by the Government of Malaysia including the Covid-19 detection test, quarantine cost and hospital admittance fee (if required) as below :

- Accommodation Cost (**Refer to square info**)
- COVID-19 Screening Test at International Entry Gate & MOH Facility
RT-PCR : RM250
RTK ANTIGEN : RM120



16 On Campus

All international students are required to remain on campus during the period of Movement Control Order (MCO). Students will be able to continue their courses via hybrid learning.



15 Undergo selfassessment at Campus

Student **MUST** undergo self assessment at Campus until completion of 14days period from the date of arrival **to Malaysia** (example if 7 days quarantine + 7 days self assessment) using Home Assessment Tool (HAT). Please scan barcode as below :



14 Return to Institution

After your quarantine period is over, students are advised to return to their institution/ accommodation immediately.



13 Release Order

Once the quarantine period is completed, students will be issued with a Release Order by the National Disaster Management Agency (NADMA). This Release Order can be used by the students to travel to your respective campus/ accommodation.



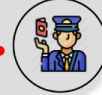
12 Undergo COVID-19 Test

RT-PCR/RTK Ag COVID-19 swab test on the 5th/8th day of the quarantine period



11 Undergo 7 or 10 days mandatory quarantine

You are required to comply with the mandatory quarantine for **7 or 10** days upon arrival to Malaysia before continuing your studies. This is subject to them furnishing their RT-PCR Covid-19 test results at the international arrival gate.



10 Travel to Malaysia

Present your Travel approval letter, Letter of Approval and receipt of the RT-PCR test to the Immigration and obtain clearance to enter Malaysia.



9 MySejahtera Apps

You are required to download the MySejahtera app from the iOS App Store or Google Play Store to complete all the required information three (3) days prior to the arrival date.

Accommodation Cost :

- **RM 150/day**
RM 1,050 (7 days to quarantine)
- **RM 1,500 (10 days to quarantine)**
- Fixed Charges
(Quarantine Station Operations : RM 2,600)
