### LOU and Indemnity & Travel 3 Upon declaration 4

Download, fill and sign the Letter of Undertaking and Undemnity (LOU) and obtain the travel notice from the nearest Malaysian Misson office nearest in your home country. Please download the LOU from:

#### Single - Entry Visa (SEV) Students from countries

that requires Single-Entry Visa (SEV) to enter Malaysia are required to submit their SEV application to the nearest Malaysian Mission Office in their countries.



#### COVID-19 test at entry 6 point

Students are required to undergo the RT-PCR Covid-19 Test three (3) days travelling to Malaysia. The RT-PCR Covid-19 test result must be translated in **ENGLISH** so that the respective authorities in Malaysia can inspect it.



#### **Online Payment**

Students to complete the online payment for the quarantine and the Covid-19 Screening Test through MySafeTravel (www.safetravel.mye g.com.my) / MyQr application by MyEG (www.myeg.gov.my) and provide the payment slip at the international entry point upon arrival.



## 8 Cost of Quarantine & COV-19

Kindly note that all fees imposed by the Government of Malaysia including the Covid-19 detection test, quarantine cost and hospital admittance fee (if required) as below:

- Accommodation Cost (Refer to square info)
- COVID-19 Screening Test at International Entry Gate & MOH Facility

RT-PCR: RM250 **RTK ANTIGEN: RM120** 



#### On Campus

16 All international 15 at Campus students are required to remain on campus during the period of Movement Control Order (MCO). Students will be able to continue their courses via hybrid learning.

### Undergo selfassesment

Student MUST undergo self assessment at Campus until completion of 14days period from the date of arrival to Malaysia (example if 7 days quarantine + 7 days self assessment) using Home Assessment Tool (HAT). Please scan barcode as below:



#### Return to Insitution

After your quarantine period is over, students are advised to return to their institution/ accommodation immediately.



Release Order
Once the quarantine 12 Undergo COVID-19
Test period is empleted, students will be issued with a Release Order by the National Disaster Management Agency (NADMA). This Release Order can be used by the students to travel to your respective campus/ accommodation.

RT-PCR/RTK Ag COVID-19 swab test on the 5th/8th day of the quarantine period



#### Undergo 7 or 10 days mandatory quarantine 10 Present your Travel

You are required to comply with the mandatory quarantine for **7 or 10** days upon arrival to Malaysia before continuing your studies. This is subject to them furnishing their RT-PCR Covid-19 test results at the international arrival gate.

### 9 MySejahtera Apps

You are required to download the MySejahtera app from the iOS App Store or Google Play Store to complete all the required information three (3) days prior to the arrival date.

#### Accommodation Cost:

- RM 150/day RM 1,050 (7 days to quarantine)
- RM 1,500 (10 days to auarantine)
- Fixed Charges (Quarantine Station Operations: RM 2,600)
