**STUDENT CIRCULAR NO. 3/2022**

**STUDENT MOVEMENT PROCEDURES  
FOR TRANSITION PHASE TO ENDEMIC  
UNIVERSITI TEKNOLOGI MALAYSIA (UTM)**

Please be informed that beginning 1 April 2022, as announced by the Government, Malaysia has entered the transition phase to endemic following the success of COVID-19 vaccination program and the under-controlled condition of the health service system. In accordance to the transition phase and the Academic Circular No. 2/2022 on Teaching and Learning Methods for The Endemic Transition Phase for Semester II Session 2021/2022 released on 31 Mac 2022, the Department of the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Student Affairs) has approved the Student Movement Procedures for the transition phase to endemic as follows:

1. Students are allowed to enter the campus starting 7 May 2022 (UTMJJB) and starting 8 May 2022 (UTMKL). Campus entry application through "Student Movement" in the UTM Smart system is therefore **TERMINATED** starting 7 May 2022. However, students must comply with the fixed Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) by referring to Student Movement Guidelines 4th Edition for student movement methods into the campus.
2. Student movement into the campus is subject to respective school/faculty teaching and learning modes. Students can refer to Teaching and Learning Methods (T&L) for the Endemic Transition Phase for Semester II Session 2021/2022 as mentioned in Academic Circular No. 2/2022.
3. Undergraduate students who wish to stay on campus in UTM Johor Bahru are required to apply in advance for the hostel through the link "hostel.utm.my" and approval is subject to vacancies at the respective residential colleges.


4. For postgraduate and international students, the application for college admission must be made by sending an e-mail addressed to colleges designated for postgraduate and international students, namely Kolej Rahman Putra, Kolej Tun Fatimah, Kolej Tun Hussein Onn (KTHO) and Kolej Tun Dr. Ismail. The application is subject to availability, and for single-rooms-with-attached-bathroom only. These student movement procedures are subject to any amendments made by the National Security Council (MKN) and the Ministry of Higher Education (KPT), and are in compliance with the established Standard Operating Procedures (SOP). The Student Movement Guidelines document is attached in the appendix.
